- **GER194H** & **GER197H** are First-Year-Foundation seminars and only open to first-year students.
- **GER205H** is a prerequisite course for all 300-level topic courses taught in German and should be taken together with GER200Y; students who have completed GER300Y may not register for it.
- **GER305H** is a prerequisite course for all 400-level topic courses taught in German and should be taken together with GER300Y
